Marshfield Area Habitat for Humanity's Don Zais Receives 2017 Andrus Award for Community Service

In October, Marshfield Area Habitat for Humanity's "Mr. Habitat", Don Zais, was presented with AARP Wisconsin's highest and most prestigious honor – the "2017 Andrus Award for Community Service". Recipients of the Andrus Award are chosen for their ability to enhance the lives of AARP members and prospective members, improve the community in which the work was performed, and inspire others to volunteer.

"This award honors Don's tireless commitment to making life better for others," said AARP Wisconsin State Director Sam Wilson. "Through decades of volunteer service, Don has built up the trust, influence and respect it takes to accomplish great things for those in need throughout the Marshfield area and across all of Wood County. Milestone Year for Habitat for Humanity

It was a milestone year for Habitat for Humanity. U.S. affiliates tithed \$14,006,000 in fiscal year 2017 (July 2016-June 2017), which represents 3,112 additional families living in safe and decent housing abroad.

All US affiliates are asked to tithe 10% of their annual unrestricted donations received to Habitat International for their work around the globe. We can choose where we want our money to go from the following categories: Global Mission Fund, Orphans and Vulnerable Groups Fund, Disaster Response Fund, or a specific National organization.

Marshfield Habitat tithed \$2,957 to Habitat's Global Mission Fund in 2017. Since 1996 MAHFH has tithed \$63,715, which has served 20 international families.
